# in Dearborn County?

## Items currently accepted for recycling:

IF IT'S NOT LISTED HERE, WE DO NOT ACCEPT IT!

(As a general rule empty, rinse, and drain all food containers)

### Aluminum Food Containers

- ONLY food or beverage containers.

**Example:** soda cans, beer cans.

### Metal Cans ( tin)

- Food or beverage containers only, including metal caps or lids.

**Example:** empty green bean and tomato sauce cans

### Glass (Clear or Colored)

- ONLY food or beverage containers.

**Example:** empty spaghetti sauce jar or beverage bottle

### Corrugated Cardboard

(Note: corrugated has ridges & furrows)

- Remove wax liners and all other debris and flatten. Clean and dry only, please.

### Plastic

#### “Check the neck”

**Example:** soda bottles, bottled water, clear juice bottles.

**Example:** laundry detergent, bleach, ketchup, mustard, and personal care products.

- Discard caps, lids, pumps, and rings.
- Flatten if you can.

**Important:** “Check the neck” — if the opening is smaller than the base, and the bottle has one of the above symbols on it, it is recyclable.

**WE DO NOT ACCEPT BOTTLES THAT CONTAINED OIL.**

### Mixed Paper

Includes junk mail, office paper, magazines, catalogs, paper board, phonebooks, and envelopes.

- Clean and dry only, please.
- Remove plastic wrap on phonebooks and magazines.

**Example:** cereal & tissue boxes, toilet paper and paper towel rolls, pop cases, construction paper, envelopes with windows, etc.

### Newspaper

- Including glossy inserts found inside. Clean and dry only, please.

28870 St. Joe Drive (SR1) - behind the fire department *(trailer changed out M, Th)*

**Dearborn County Recycling Center Drive Thru, 10700 Prospect Lane in Aurora, every Friday Noon to 6 pm and Saturday 9 am to 1 pm (except holidays)**

**Appliances**

- With or without Freon
- Limit of 2 with Freon without charge

**Batteries**

- Household - all sizes and types
- Automotive batteries

**Mercury Products**

- Thermometers
- Compact and tube fluorescent light bulbs

**Tires**

- Up to 5 passenger tires per resident without charge
- Fee for additional passenger tires
- Fees for all semi & tractor tires

**Scrap Metal**

- No Fencing
- No tires, oil or gas in lawn mowers and trimmers

**MOOFA**

- Motor Oil—limit 5 gallons per visit
- Oil Filters
- Antifreeze

**Electronics**

- Any electrical or electronic item or component
- \$10 fee for TVs over 39"                      \$10 fee for office copiers
